2005 South End Club Crop Schedule

This month's Saturday crop will be held on March 19 from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm at the Kent Activity Center, bldg 7-226, rooms A&B. There will be a class held at 10 AM this month. See the "Classes" section below for details. The page layout theme for this month is "Tags".

Friday Crops: We meet the 1st Friday of the month. All south end Friday night crops have been scheduled from 5:00 pm to 11:00 pm. The crop dates for the rest of the year are: April 1, May 6, June 3, July 1, August 5, September 2, October 7, November 4, and December 2.

Saturday Crops: We meet the 3rd Saturday of the month. All south end Saturday crops have been scheduled from 9:00 am to 6:00 pm. The crop dates for the rest of the year are: March 19, April 16, May 21, June 18, July 16, August 20, September 17, October 15, November 19, and December 17.

2005 Everett Club Crop Schedule

This month's crop will be on Saturday, March 12 from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm. The crop dates for the rest of the year are: March 12, April 9, May 14, June 11, July 9, August 13, September 10, October 8, November 12, and December 10.

Saturday crops: All Everett Saturday crops have been scheduled from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm the 2nd Saturday of the month at the Everett Activity Center. The room we meet in is at the right as you enter the premises.

Page Layout Themes for Saturday Contest

A page layout contest is being held each month for best layout for the theme that month. The vote is from the members and guests attending that meeting. Once a page or double page layout has been entered it cannot be used again for any other theme. Each chapter decides on contest themes, prizes and voting time for each month independently of each other. For the south end voting occurs right after the business meeting or about 2:00 pm if there is no meeting. There were no entries for the months of January and February.

Classes

Each chapter decides when they want to schedule classes, the types of classes they want, and the fee they are willing to pay each month independently of each other. The Kent chapter has classes for March and April. **The class for the March 19 crop is Paper Piecing and possibility of using other techniques, as well. The cost will be \$13 and the class will be at 10 AM. This class is considered Moderate to Advanced. There will be kits provided for you. Please bring your basic tools for the class: adhesive, scissors, paper trimmer, and a black pen.
